### **Who can participate?**

Any utility in the NWMOA region (Alaska, Idaho, Montana, North Dakota, Oregon, South Dakota, Utah, Washington and Wyoming) that uses membrane treatment in the production of its drinking water is invited to submit a sample for judging. Facilities that do not use membranes in some stage of drinking water production are not eligible to enter.

### **How to enter:**

Please submit the attached completed entry form to NWMOA by **Friday, June 29, 2018** to sign up to participate in the contest. You can either drop off your sample on the day of the contest, or have your sample shipped to the hotel ahead of time. If you plan to drop off your sample, please submit your entry to the NWMOA Staff at workshop registration **no later than 8:00 a.m. on Wednesday, July 18, 2018 (no exceptions)**. ### **Instructions for sample:**

Please follow the instruction below when preparing your water sample:

- Collect sample from water system no more than 48 hours prior to the competition on 7/18/18
- Place sample in a sealed 1 quart glass container
- Store and maintain sample at a temperature between 60 and 70 degrees Fahrenheit
- Do not chill the water sample or the sample will be disqualified
- Do not label the sample with your utility name or any other identifying marks

**Only samples submitted in the correct sealed 1 quart glass container will be considered – no exceptions.** NWMOA staff will track samples as they are turned in and assign anonymous labels to each sample. The public water system must comply with all Maximum Contaminant Levels and Treatment Technique requirements, and must not have any potable water quality violations from a regulatory agency in 2017 or 2018, or be under regulatory consent decree or order for its potable water quality.

### **Judging:**

For each entry, individual samples will be prepared. Each judge will be given one sample of each entry. The judges will evaluate the sample on the following scale:

- Taste 1-5 (1 being poor and 5 being best)
- Odor 1-5 (1 being poor and 5 being best)
- Color 1-5 (1 being poor and 5 being best)
- Clarity 1-5 (1 being poor and 5 being best)
- Mouthfeel 1-5 (1 being poor and 5 being best)
- Aftertaste 1-5 (1 being poor and 5 being best)
- Following Submission Instructions (1 being poor and 5 being best)

The sample with the highest cumulative score will be given the title of “2018 Best Tasting Membrane Water” The runner up will also be recognized.
